THE MISSION OF TAYLOR MADE FÚTBOL INITIATIVE



The Taylor Made Fútbol Initiative is bringing elite soccer fundamentals and technical training institutions from Spain to the inner cities of the Southeast.



The Taylor Made Fútbol Initiative (TMFI) was established to bring high-quality soccer training and technical expertise to underprivileged inner cities in the Southeast United States. The brainchild of Barrett Green, a former NFL Linebacker who wanted a different lifestyle for his son, TMFI was created in honor of one of his best friends, Sean Taylor, who tragically lost his life defending his family against a home invasion. Barrett brings lessons learned from professional sports, and exposure to the highest levels of youth soccer, to inner cities in the U.S.

By utilizing the game of soccer and its associated virtues, the Taylor Made Futbol Initiative offers a unique educational pathway that equips individuals for success in life. TMFI endeavors to provide inner-city youth in the Southeast with opportunities to pursue college scholarships both domestically and internationally through professional soccer leagues such as La Liga, Bundesliga, Serie A, and MLS.

The comprehensive TMFI program incorporates various aspects of youth development including nutrition, academics, behavior, and psycho-social elements. With a primary focus on development rather than competition, the TMFI has enlisted Professional American Football Players (Ambassadors) who have established relationships within their respective communities, to actively engage and rally youth participation.

As part of our efforts, TMFI will bring soccer coaches directly from Spain to conduct teaching and host free camps in inner city parks during the summer months. As a starting point, interested children will be registered in the Bennett Southeast League, spanning from Miami to Riviera Beach. We have ambitious goals for growth, aiming to have over 10,000 youth registered in our database by the end of 2024. The Bennett Southeast League will exclusively compete within individual states, starting with Florida. On an international scale, All-Star teams will have opportunities to travel and compete in the Valencia Region of Spain, with planned trips to Rosario, Argentina

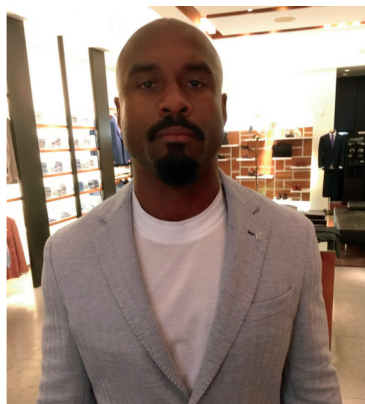
